Radiology for the Non-Radiologist

PURPOSE & LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Many clinicians are sometimes confused about what Radiology has to offer them for the work-up of their patients. Following this course, the participant should better understand the different radiologic studies available to them for working up the conditions covered during this conference. This should improve patient outcomes, help lower medical costs for unnecessary examinations ordered, and potentially help lower the radiation doses to the patient. Many medical/ surgical conditions that will likely be encountered in their daily practices will be shown, and the imaging which best evaluates these abnormalities. A link to the ACR Appropriateness Criteria will also be provided for future reference. This course is designed to help direct the non-radiologist in deciding the appropriate study for their patient's condition and inform them what information they can obtain from this study. It will also help them in interpreting certain basic studies to help them in their clinical work.

At the conclusion of this activity, the attendees will be

- 1. Recognize subtle findings in child abuse.
- 2. Review the ACR guidelines for imaging specific clinical symptoms.


