# SINUS DISSECTION COURSE

## **BACKGROUND**

12 million Americans suffer from chronic sinusitis. The primary surgical treatment for chronic sinus issues is endoscopic sinus surgery. This is one of the most common procedures performed by ENTs in the country. This course is designed to provide otolaryngologists with information and laboratory experience regarding advanced techniques and approaches in endoscopic sinus surgery. The content will include recent advances in endoscopic sinus surgery including orbital and skull base considerations.
